Dear Mr. Jones,

The purpose of this letter is to respond to your June 1, 1989 letter requesting a clarification of Ford Motor Company's warranty policy on the use of non-Ford aftermarket service parts.

The inclusion of your product in a vehicle is considered a modification of the vehicle through the installation of non-Ford parts. The installation of your Brake-Guard product/system will not void the Ford vehicle warranty or Extended Service Plan coverage. If, however, the installation or use of your Brake-Guard product/system causes a Ford part to fail, the cost of the repair is not covered by the Ford vehicle or extended warranty. The vehicle owner would have to look to the seller of the Brake-Guard product/system for repair of the affected parts as well as any related damage.
